

HAVE/ HAS FUNCTIONS,

Basically, the functions of have/ has can be divided by 3. They are:

1. As full verb (**have/ has + noun**)

Formula: → **S + HAVE/HAS + O**

Examples:

- I have a dog
- She has a beautiful book

2. As auxiliary verb (**have/has + to**) **it has the same meaning with must which has function as Necessity,** examples:

- We have to go home, because our parents are waiting us
- He has to leave the class because the time is already over

Formula: → **S + HAVE/HAS + TO + V1 + O (ADV)**

3. As perfect sentences (**have/ has + V3**)

Formula: → **S + HAVE/HAS + V3/BEEN + O (ADV)**

Examples:

- I have eaten with my friend before lunch time
- She has gone in a few minutes ago
